Introduction

Overview

Pacific Pines State High School has a complete dress and sport uniform. A gender-neutral school uniform helps in achieving the school's identity, cohesion, tone, pride, and spirit. Students at Pacific Pines State High School are permitted to choose the formal uniform in which they feel most comfortable. ALL students are required to wear the uniform correctly and are encouraged to take pride in their appearance by keeping their uniform neat and tidy. This policy seeks to assist students and parents by identifying requirements and expectations for as many uniform and appearance items as possible.

Relevant Legislation

This Uniform Policy has been developed in accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (Sections 360-363) ["The Act"] and the Department of Education and Training policy SMS-PR-022: Student Dress Code in relation to implementing student dress codes in Queensland State schools. It clearly explains and outlines the standards of acceptable dress at Pacific Pines State High School.

Uniform Expectations

It is expected that all students at Pacific Pines State High School will wear the uniform correctly and with pride. All students in Years 7-10 wear the sports uniform every day. All Year 11 & 12 students must wear the formal uniform every day.

Students in Year 10 are welcome to wear the formal uniform, but there is no expectation to do so. However, the sport uniform must be worn for physical activities. Students in Years 11 & 12 who participate in practical subjects requiring the sports uniform (e.g., Physical Education or Sport & Recreation) must change into the sports uniform for their practical lesson, then change back into their formal uniform at the next available break time. There will be some occasions such as excursions or special events for which the formal uniform must be worn (senior students only). Please refer to the tables below for a summary of uniform requirements and approved styles.

The school uniform must not be altered or modified to change its appearance in any way. For students requiring special consideration in relation to the school uniform policy for medical or religious reasons, amendments are available upon written application with supporting medical documentation and/or a letter of support from a religious leader to the relevant phase Deputy Principal.

Specific Uniform Requirements

Formal Skirt: The skirt must come to the top of the student's knees. The skirt will include the school logo which must be visible.

Sport Shorts: Students will need the PPSH sport uniform for participation in physical activity. Shorts are not to be rolled or folded at the waist band.

Undershirt: Students may choose to wear a white undershirt. This must be short sleeved, plain, and unseen.

Tracksuit: The school tracksuit can be worn with either the formal or sports uniform. Hooded jumpers or jackets are not permitted at any time with or without parent approval. Hooded jumpers or jackets must be removed and handed into Student Services to be collected at the end of the day.

Shoes: All black leather/synthetic leather-look upper, enclosed, and impervious shoes must be worn at all times. *N.B: Boots, hi-tops, platforms, mesh, canvas or 'mary-jane' shoes are **NOT** permitted as they do not meet our Workplace Health and Safety requirements.*

Socks: Socks must be plain and white. Girls may wear black- or skin-coloured stockings in winter.

Junior School Uniform: Years 7 – 8

All students in Years 7-8 wear the [sports uniform](#) every day.

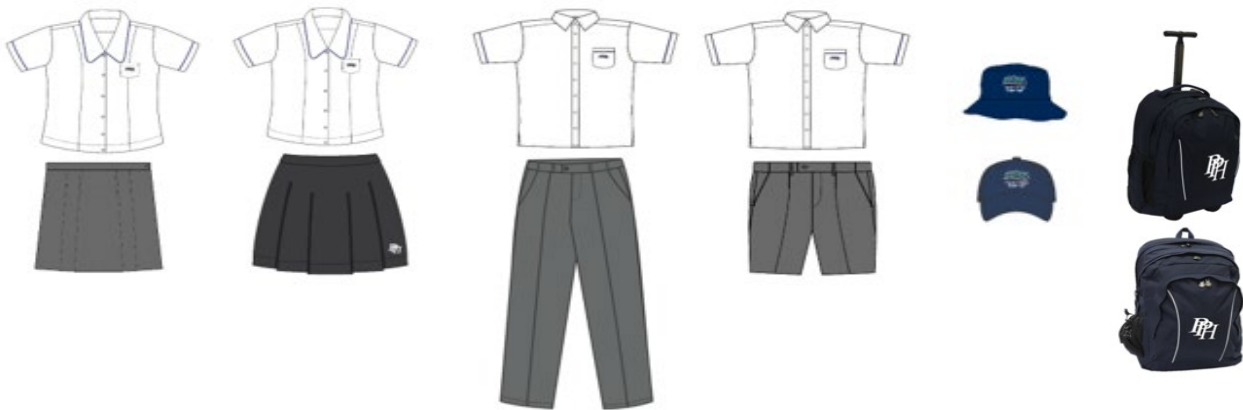

Senior School Uniform: Years 11 – 12

Students in Years 11 & 12 who participate in practical subjects requiring the [sports uniform](#) (e.g., Physical Education or Sport & Recreation) must change into the sports uniform for their practical lesson, then change back into their [formal uniform](#) at the next available break time.

Approved Shoes

Students who arrive at school wearing incorrect shoes are required to change into shoes provided by Student Services. The process will be as follows:

1. **Shoe Exchange:** Students will borrow appropriate shoes from Student Services for the day. Their incorrect shoes will be left in Student Services and returned to them at the end of the day.
2. **Hygiene Protocol:** The shoes provided by the school will be thoroughly disinfected and sprayed with anti-fungal protectant after each use. Students are required to wear socks with the shoes to ensure hygiene is maintained.
3. **Refusal to Comply:** Any student who refuses to change into the provided shoes will be sent home.

We understand that there may be exceptional circumstances, such as wet weather events or other unforeseen situations, where flexibility is required. In these cases, leeway will be provided, and we encourage you to communicate any concerns in advance.

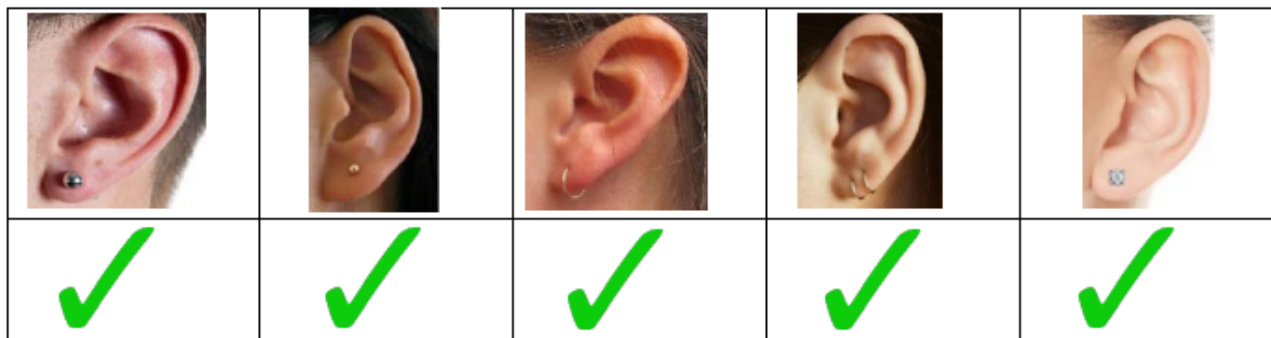
Hat and Bag: Years 7 - 12

The PPSHS school backpack and PPSHS bucket hat and/or cap are compulsory for all students. At lunch break students are required to wear a hat in designated areas (**See map on last page**). The school bag must not be defaced, altered, or graffitied in any way.

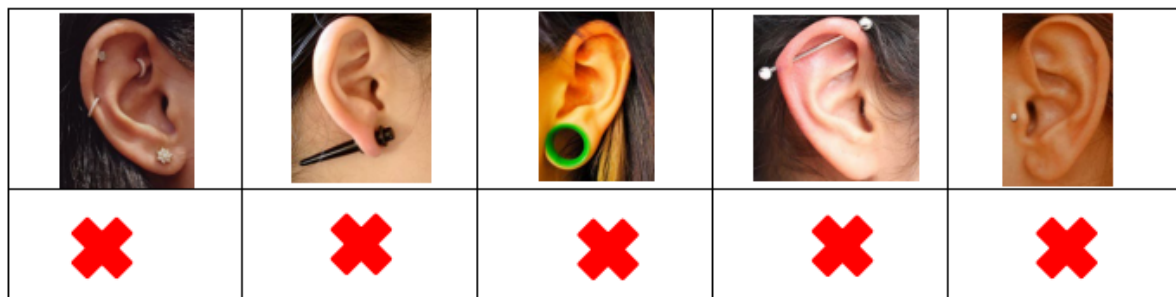
Jewellery and Piercings: Years 7 – 12

No jewellery other than a wristwatch and two small plain sleepers or small plain studs per pierced ear are permitted. Nose piercings must be clear and flat only (no studs or rings). Septum piercings are not permitted. No other facial piercings or ear piercings covered with tape are permitted. Refer to the table below for examples of approved and non-approved earrings.

Hair, Nails and Makeup: Years 7 - 12

Hair and make-up are to be that which is suitable for the workplace.

Hair must be pulled back to comply with workplace health and safety requirements, preferably with hair ties. Bandanas are not permitted.

Nails are to be an appropriate length (not to exceed 7mm) and shape for the workplace.

- Nails may need to be taped for practical lessons in some subjects including but not limited to Science, HPE, Hospitality, and IDT at the discretion of the teacher.
- Nail colours can be French tip (white or nude), shades of 'nudes' or clear – bright colours or unnatural colours are not permitted.

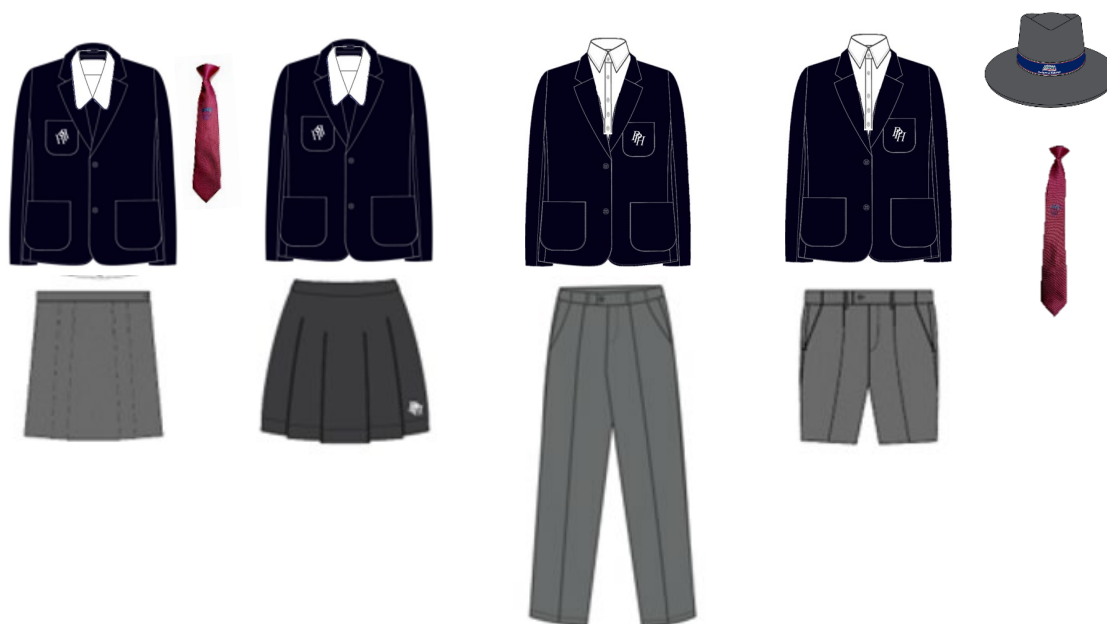
Please refer to the diagram below for examples of permitted and non-permitted nails.

Makeup: Makeup should be of natural skin tones or translucent. Sunscreen is always encouraged.



Representational Uniform

At times, students will represent Pacific Pines State High School in public appearances for events such as ANZAC Day, awards nights or other school functions as specified. Years 7 to 12 students are to wear the correct formal uniform for all formal occasions. School Leaders will be issued with their own representational uniform including the Dawson Felt hat. Other students who require a blazer and tie may borrow these from the school.

The blue school bucket hat is reversible showing the house colours of the student's allocated House. The House hats are encouraged to be worn to our Cross Country and Athletics Carnival events.

Centre of Excellence

Several Centre of Excellence (CoE) programs require the purchase of specialised, compulsory uniforms that students must wear when representing the school at competitions and events, as well as during specific timetabled lessons.

Students are required to change into and/or out of the specialised uniform for lessons at the specific times outlined in the table below.

Socks	White socks visible to the ankle bone

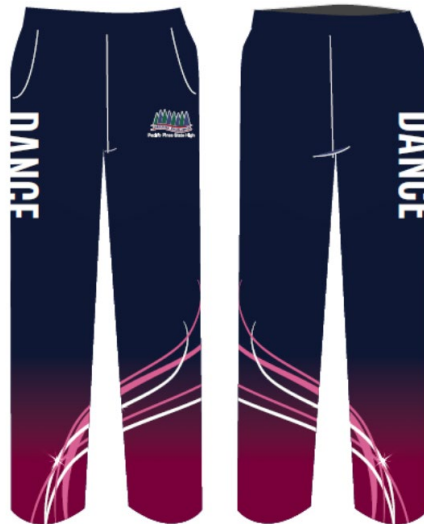
CoE Dance Performance Uniform
