Important information:

- A Year 7 2025 student can be accepted into a maximum of 3 Centre of Excellence programs.
- For the Elective C category, a student will be enrolled in one program only (their first preference if relevant).
- *English, Literature & Media (ELM)* and *STEM-Mathematics & Science* programs are rigorous.
- Acceptance into the Excellence programs is conditional on numbers, staffing and timetabling.

If applying for *English, Literature & Media* it is recommended that the following apply to your student:

- Has achieved a B or higher for English on their last two report cards.
- Yr5 Naplan results for Reading, Writing and Language conventions were Band 7 or 8.

If applying for *STEM-Mathematics & Science* it is recommended that the following apply to your student:

- Has achieved a B or higher for Mathematics and Science on their last two report cards.
- Yr5 Naplan results for Reading, Writing and Numeracy were Band 7 or 8.

Please note:

Students applying for Academic programs will be required to complete an Entrance exam on Saturday 15 June 2024:

- English, Literature & Media
 - STEM- Mathematics & Science
 - Japanese Excellence
 - STEM- Technology
- Applications for these programs close on the 7 June 2024.

Students applying for Creative Industries and Enterprise programs will be required to attend an audition/trial:

- Dance Excellence
- Drama Excellence
- Music Excellence
- Culinary Skills

Rounds 1 and 2 will be held on 7- 9 May 2024, or 29 July – 1 August 2024.

Applications will close for Round 1 on the 24 April 2024, and Round 2 on the 18 July 2024.

Conditions:

Upon acceptance into one or more Centre of Excellence programs, an agreement is required from both the student and parent/carer to uphold the conditions of the 'Centre of Excellence Student Agreement Contract' which is provided post acceptance. It aligns with, but is not limited to, factors identified and described in the prospectus, including:

- Minimum C Level of Achievement (LOA) for all subjects on Semester 1 and 2 report card.
- Minimum B LOA for English, Literature & Media on Semester 1 and 2 report card.
- Minimum B LOA for STEM- Science & Mathematics on Semester 1 and 2 report card.
- 'Very good' or 'Excellent' Effort and Behaviour, for Centre of Excellence programs, on Semester 1 and 2 report card.
- Minimum 'Satisfactory' Effort and Behaviour, for all subjects that are not part of the Centre of Excellence, on Semester 1 and 2 report card.
- No more than 2 behaviour incident reports on OneSchool.
- No suspension.
- Attendance remains 92% or above.
- Participation in, and payment for, the Student Resource Scheme (SRS) and Excellence program fee/s.
- Accept that my student will receive an adapted version of the Australian Curriculum due to their enrolment in Centre of Excellence program/s.
